
WHEREAS, the 22nd Judicial Circuit, McHenry County, Illinois, has collected data to determine the efficacy of the Drug Court, Mental Health Court, and the DUI Court Programs, and desires to engage eMoksha, a data science company, to utilize artificial intelligence-based pattern analysis, to look for correlations and commonalities between individuals who successfully complete one of the programs; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the project is to enable the Court to improve outcomes, efficiency, and effectiveness, and this includes access to and review of the collected data, including confidential and identifying information.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that representatives of eMoksha shall have electronic access to the collected court data and shall be allowed to review said data. Any confidential or identifying information of clients of the Department of Court Services and Probation and the Office of Special Projects shall remain confidential and shall not be disclosed by eMoksha representatives or agents who access or review the data. Any information, reports, analysis, and work product produced by eMoksha shall only be disseminated to representatives of the 22nd Judicial Circuit, McHenry County, Illinois, and may not be released to any other individual, entity, or organization, without the prior written authorization of the Circuit.
